How to get here

From **Tiverton** take the A396 to Dulverton. Follow road to Exeter Arms then turn left, signed Dulverton (ignore brown sign). At Exbridge bear right and then follow brown signs to Wimbleball via Brompton Regis village.

From **Dunster** take the A396 towards Dulverton. Just after the Dulverton turning take a left following brown signs through Brompton Regis Village.

From **Taunton** take the A39 towards Minehead. After Bishops Lydeard take the B3224 signed Elworthy. This road joins the B3190, continue until you see the brown 'Wimbleball lake/ Brompton Regis sign.
