How to get here

The lake is just off the A30 between Okehampton and Launceston in Devon. So, whether approaching from the East or West look out for the brown signs for Roadford Lake and exit the A30 at Broadwoodwidge. (Both of the slip roads off the A30 are quite short and have sharp bends - towing vehicles are advised to slow down for them!)

From the East...

If coming from the East, turn right at the first junction after the A30 exit and follow the road for about 3 miles. You will see the dam with the lake on your right hand side. Go over the dam and take the first right into the Watersports Centre.

From the West...

If coming from the West turn left at the first junction after the A30 and follow the road for about 3 miles. You will see the dam with the lake on your right hand side. Go over the dam and take the first right into the Watersports Centre.
